- Goa enjoys extensive rail connectivity with the rest of the country. The rail route into Goa is a soothing journey that takes you through some of the most beautiful landscapes of the Western Ghats.
- Today, the high-speed Konkan Railway has a daily train from Mumbai which takes around 8 hours of travel. Goa has two major railway stations — Margao and Vasco-da-Gama, both located in the southern area of the state.
